## ***Sunday Morning Nursery***

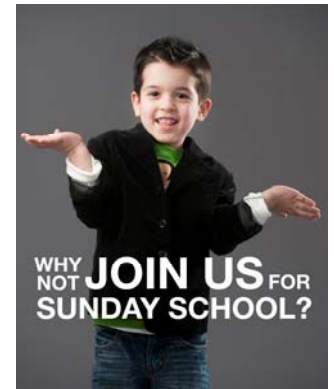
